What does the Course involve?

E-mail communication is preferred. Six question papers will be sent at fortnightly intervals, and all should be answered. Those persons who do not have access to e-mail may conduct all correspondence by normal surface mail. There will be two seminars held where practical demonstrations will take place. The final examination will be set by NZ Golf.

You will always have your 2016-2019 Rule Book beside you to find the right answers.

When does the Course take place?

It is proposed to start early in April and finish in July.

Qualifications:

- 90% - 100% Honours Pass
- 80% - 89% A Grade Pass
- 70% - 79% B Grade Pass
